The new poker dealing class started with 69 candidates and only 30 were selected, 22 being current team members. Students will learn the method and procedures of how to deal Texas Hold 'em and the card game Omaha.

Martin's path has come full circle, from student to teacher. His growth in the enterprise is inspirational and shows that with hard work and dedication to your craft, everyone can excel here at Gila River Resorts & Casinos. ### Gila River RISE UP Program frequently asked Questions

### What should Team Members do if they want to learn more about the program?

Team Members should visit https://gilarivergaming.instride.com/ to get details about the program and request information about learning options. They should not go directly to Arizona State University.

### Who is eligible to participate in the Gila River Rise Up Program?

All Gila River Resorts & Casinos employees are eligible to participate in the program as of their hire date.

Members of the Gila River Indian Community should contact the Tribal Education team to learn more about the benefits available to them.

### What does the program include and how much scholarship is provided?

The Gila River Gaming Program will provide a 20% tuition scholarship toward their choice of more than 200+ undergraduate and graduate studies offered online from ASU.

Participating students are responsible for any remaining tuition and additional expenses such as application fees, books and supplies.

### What happens if an employee leaves Gila River Resorts & Casinos while participating in the program?

If the employee is enrolled in courses at the time they leave, they will be able to finish the current session, but they will not be able to continue participation in the Gila River Rise Up Program nor continue receiving the tuition scholarship. They will be able to continue their education with the academic institution if they wish, but students will be responsible for any future tuition costs if they are no longer employed by Gila River Resorts & Casinos.


